The following questions correspond to today's sermon on Acts 1:1-11. Read these questions with your family and discuss your answers.

1. What stood out to you the most from today's message and why?
2. If you learned something new from this passage, or something stuck out to you for the first time today, what was it?
3. If you were reminded of a truth you had forgotten about the Holy Spirit and how it works in people's lives, what was it?
4. After we've received the power of the Holy Spirit, how will our lives be changed? How will it, or should it, affect those around us?
5. Is there something that you learned that you could apply to your life today? What actions do you need to take today in applying what you learned so you don't forget tomorrow?
